VOCATIONAL SCHOOL & CERTIFICATE PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The 808-812 Memorial Drive Scholarship Fund was established in 2008 to provide financial assistance to residents of 808-812 Memorial Drive who are pursuing career advancement through vocational school or a certificate program. Scholarship applicants are eligible to receive assistance for the full term of their education at an accredited, Title IV funded institution of post secondary education. Award amounts will be determined based on individual program costs and demonstrated financial need.

Eligibility Requirements:

In order to be eligible for the 808-812 Memorial Drive Scholarship Fund, the following requirements must be met:

- Must reside in a rent-assisted apartment at 808-812 Memorial Drive
- Must be attending or have received admittance to an accredited Title IV funded vocational school or certificate program.
- Demonstrated financial need
- Demonstrated technical/vocational/academic promise and achievement
- Demonstrated community service and community involvement

Application Submission Documents:

- Completed application form
- Proof of acceptance (acceptance letter/verification of enrollment)
- Two letters of recommendation (a personal reference and a job or academic reference)
- Copy of financial aid award letter from vocational or certificate program
- Evidence of program accreditation and program details for which you will be attending. Any information you have on the program including flyers, program brochures, printout / link to online information on school program would be helpful.
